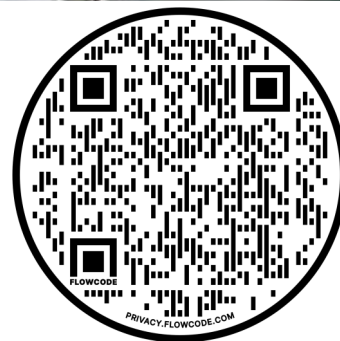
# Free CNC Operator Training beginning September 2023 at Smith Vocational and Agricultural High School in Northampton, MA
