

Free Welding and Metal Fabrication Training Program beginning March 10th, 2025

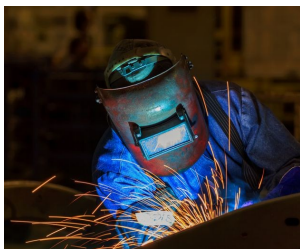
Train for a Career with a Future!

The Sheet Metal Local 63 Union, located in Springfield, will be providing pre-apprenticeship technical training in basic welding and metal fabrication to unemployed adults.

Trainees will learn blueprint reading, shop math, basic welding and how to setup and utilize basic fabrication tools and shop equipment.



- ◆ Average Starting Wages \$18-\$21 per hour with quick increases
- ◆ Career pathways to Apprentice opportunities may be available
- ◆ 10 Week, 165 Hours of late afternoon/early evening training
- ◆ Monday– Thursday on-campus training at Local 63 Training Facility in Springfield from 4:30 pm-8:30pm



Trainee Requirements

- Unemployed
- Legally able to work in the United States
- State or federal ID
- Have transportation to training (limited bus service in evening)
- Provide Resume
- Complete all required documentation with career center
