



UNIVERSAL ACCESS ASSISTIVE TECHNOLOGY

MassHire Holyoke Career Center is equipped to accommodate job seekers living with disabilities. The following assistive technology is available in the Resource Center upon request. To request accommodation, please call 413-322-4900, or email info@masshireholyokey.org.

- **Zoom Text** – Screen enlarger which magnifies text and images and computer screen from 2 to 18 inches.
- **JAWS** – a voice synthesizer which outputs computer contents through its speakers.
- **CCTV** – an auto focus video magnifier that enables the user to view printed matter in an enlarged mode.
- **Scanner** – a necessary tool in the process of converting printed documents into formats that can be read with Zoom Text and JAWS software.
- **Dragon Naturally Speaking** – hands free speech recognition software which enables the user to access the web, email, and perform computer functions.
- **Kensington Mouse** – a trackball computer mouse that enables the user to perform mouse functions with reduced hand wrist movements.
- **Big Keys** – keyboard with enlarged keys, also has a built in assist mode, built in sticky key feature which allows the user to enter keyboard functions without simultaneous key presses.
- **Braille Labeler** – Provide means to identify and label disks, documents, and other information
- **Adjustable table** – electronically powered table that adjusts its height with a push of the button.
- **Word Q** – software writing tool that is used to provide spelling, grammar and reading assistance. It has work prediction to suggest words to use and provides spoken (text to speech) feedback. It also acts as a text reader to proofread work.
- **Pocket Talkers, FM Loop, TTY, and Telephone with Amplification** – Several tools to enhance better sound understanding in individual or group settings.
- **Communication Access for Deaf and Hard of Hearing job seekers** – upon request, interpreters and CART services are secured through the Massachusetts Commission for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing.
- **Kurzweil 1000 and 3000** – Reading software that works with a computer and scanner to make electronic text available to people with visual difficulties.
- **Oversize Computer Monitor**
- **FM Loop** – Radio transmitter with 4 wireless receivers for hard of hearing customers participating in workshops.
- **Telephone with Amplification** – Amplifies sound for the hard of hearing.
- **TTY** – Device that enables deaf customers to contact employers and community resources via phone.
- **Digital Voice Recorder** – Use for note taking in meetings and workshops.
- **Braille Labeler** – Use to label formatted disks, materials, and signage.
