

We will also discuss how ATS benefits employers, and apply that knowledge to the online application process in order to maximize your chances of getting an interview.

Slay Your Resume (In Person): In this Resume Workshop you will find out what gets a resume noticed and put to the top of the "Yes" pile. We will go over some best practices, as well as Do's and Don'ts to make a positive impression. This workshop is good for people who need to improve their existing resume, are in the beginning stages of creating one, or for those who are just not quite sure why they are not getting interviews!
